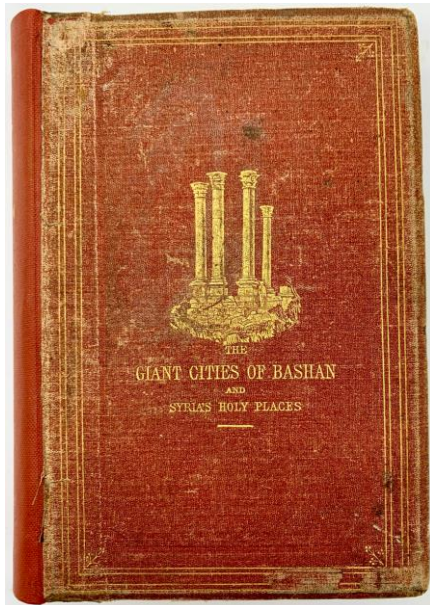
"In short, the whole appears to have been caused by a chain of events which could no more be foreseen than prevented!"
